TRANSPORT GUIDELINES

- 1. Students having the Transport Card can only board the Bus.
- 2. Students can avail the school transport arrangements subject to the availability of seats. Bus routes cannot be altered to suit individual convenience.
- 3. Students are not premitted to travel by any other bus except the one allotted to them.
- 4. Each bus user is expected to board/get down from the school bus only at his/her regular stop, not just anywhere as per his/her convenience
- 5. Parents are requested to ensure that their wards are escorted to and from the bus, especially the EP section.
- 6. To withdraw from the bus availing facility /change of route of already availing bus /apply for the bus service, Parents have to inform the office.
- 7. Bus Service will be cancelled for children found misbehaving in the bus.
- 8. Once a Student avail bus facility for a day, full monthly transport fees are to be paid.

GENERAL INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS

Note

- 1. The students must bring the diary to school every day.
- 2. Parents must see this Almanac every day. This will help them in keeping in touch with their child's day to day activities. The Almanac should be kept with care. All remarks, if any, of the teacher should be countersigned.
- 3. If and when there is **Any change in the Residential/office Address and contact numbers,** it should be immediately amended in this Almanac and intimated to the school office.
- 4. Any communication to the Administrators/Teachers by the parents should be made through the School Almanac.
- 6. The observance of rules and good behaviour shall be a condition essential to a student's continuance in the school.
- 7. Girls should not apply nail polish or mehndi during the school session. Flashy and dangling ear adornments are not permitted, very small studs or earrings in gold or silver can be worn. Trendy hairstyles, coloring and streaking of hair is not permitted. Long hair must be plaited or tied up neatly in navy blue / black Rubber bands or Ribbons.
- 8. Boys should get their hair trimmed at regular intervals. Trendy hairstyles coloring and streaking of hair is not permitted, Ear adornments, wrist band and chains are not permitted.
- 9. Speaking of English is mandatory once you enter the School Campus.
- 10. School Campus / Class Rooms / Surrounding Neighbourhood should be absolutely free from litter and graffiti.
- 11. The School Campus is a **TOBACCO FREE ZONE** Therefore all are instructed to abide by it.

DISCIPLINARY MEASURES

- 1. Fine to be imposed and amount to be decided by the School Authority incase of
 - a) Damaging / Disfiguring School Property / School Bus wilfully or accidentaly.

- b) Damaging / Scribbling / tearing pages / not returing the Library book etc.
- 2. Mobile Phones and Valuable articles should not be bought to the School. Incase if found it would be confisticated by the School Authority.
- 3. Strict disciplinary action amounting to even explusion will be taken aganist those Students who are found abusing illegal substances such as Drugs, Alcohol, Tabacco etc.

WHAT TO DO WHEN YOU ARE AWAY FROM SCHOOL Leave:-

Every absence/sick leave must be entered briefly and signed by the parent's in the leave column of the Almanac. For a leave of more than two days a formal application (accompained by a medical certificate in case of the sickness) is required.

Continued absence for more than 6 days without any leave application or information can render the name of the student liable to be struck off from the school rolls.

If you need to leave school during the day

Bring a note in the Almanac signed by your Parent or Guardian explaining the circumstance. Show the note to the class teacher.

First Aid

First aids kits are available in the school premises. In the event of illness/injury the student is taken to the Infirmary and Parent are informed as soon as possible.

WITHDRAWAL

- 1. For any withdrawal from the school, at least one month's notice is required, failing which, fee of the additional month will be charged from the student concerned.
- 2. If a child has to be withdrawn from the school, parents are requested to give one month's prior notice before the end of the session in writing addressed to the Administrator. Full Annual Charges are to be paid if withdrawn/ expelled during sessions for any reason whatsoever.
- 3. The Transfer Certificate will be issued only after getting clearance from all the departments and only after all dues are settled
- 4. The application form may be TYPED/HANDWRITTEN and submitted to the school office for further necessary action, clearly stating the reason for withdrawal
- 5. Students can be asked to leave the school on the following grounds:
 - a) Indicipline
 - b) Detention or repeated detention in class.
 - c) Violation of School / Hotel Rules.
- 6. Once the students joins this school, he/she has to complete 3 (three) Academic years T.C./P.C.R. Book will not be issued till he/she completes 3 (three) academic years.
- 7. In case the Parents/Guardians insist on taking a T.C. in the middle of the Academic session he/she has to pay the full school/hostel fees etc. for the whole year 3 years, which ever may be applicable. This is done because the School has already reserved your child's seat.
- 8. T.C. has to be applied for before the final results. It will not be entertained afterwards.

EXAMINATION AND PROMOTION

- 1. Report of FA's/SA's and CT's will be given in the Pupils' Report Card. Parents or Guardians should sign them regularly and follow the progress of their wards.
- 2. Students who are absent from an examination for any reason will not be re-examined; mark obtained in the FA's/SA's/CT's will determine the promotion. No excuses or dubious request will be entertained.
- 3. Proportionate dues/fees must be cleared before sitting for an examination, unless any other direction is given by the Administrator.
- 4. All dues must be cleared before the commencement of Promotion or else the student may not be allowed to sit for said Exams.
- 5. A student who fails twice consecutively in the same class will be issued a T.C. and will not be allowed to continue in the school.
- 6. For any one found cheating in Exams, stern action will be taken as per the gravity of the case against the students(s), such as:
 - a) Alloting zero marks in the concerned subject.
 - b) Change of answer script and issue of fresh answer script to write Exam but without extra time.
 - c) Retention in the same class in the coming year or T.C. may be issued.

CRITERIA FOR PROMOTION

Promotion is granted on the basis of the whole year's performance of the pupil, including Scholastic and Co-scholastic hence the importance of regualarity in attendance and work is always stressed.

NORMS FOR BOARDERS

- 1. All hostellers are expected to follow the rules of conduct applicable to the students of the school in the areas of responsible conduct, proper uniform, classroom attendance and appearing in the FA's / SA's / CT's.
- 2. Any absence from the classrooms/ non-appearance in the Test requires the sanction of the hostel warden and immediate information of the same to the Administrator/Warden/Hostel in-charge.
- 3. All hostellers are encouraged to make the best use of the infrastructure provide in the hostel and to protect it from damage.
- 4. Careless breakage or damage is likely to lead to a penalty, the nature of which shall be decided by the Hostel Warden.
- 5. It is mandatory for all the Parents/Local Guardians to attend Parents-Teachers Meeting in order to be fully acquainted with the progress being made by their wards.
- 6. Children will be allowed to go for their monthly outings only on the specified Saturdays of the month. Please ensure that the students report back to the hostel on the specific day, date and time, as given in the fixtures.
- 7. If any student overstays his/her outing and return late to the hostel, he/she will not be accepted by the Hostel Warden unless for genuine medical reasons. Fines will be imposed on students reporting late without information unless for a genuine medical reason.
- 8. Full Annual Charges are to be paid if withdrawn/expelled during the session for any reason whatsoever.
- 9. Hostellers shall pay special attention to cleanliness, good manners, discipline and do everthing to maintain the peaceful atmosphere and good name of the Hostel.
- 10. Parents/Guardians are to be entertained in the parlour only. No visitor is allowed to enter nor stay in any room or cubicle of the Hostel.

- 11. Hostellers are expected to assist the Hostel in-Charge in carrying out his duties, or any teacher when assistance is required.
- 12. Parents/Guardians, on their arrival, must report to the Office or Hostel Warden and ask for students they want to meet. They most not directly contact the child.
- 13. Close relatives may visit a student only with a written letter of consent from his/her parents.
- 14. Visitors other than immediate relatives may visit a student only with his/her Parent's express leave, given in writing to the Administrator/Hostel in-charge.
- Hostellers, both on leaving the Hostel and on returning, must be accompanied by their parents or by a person duly authorised by them.
- 16. Boarders deliberately reporting later than the alloted time and date will be fined Rs. 500/- (Rupees Five hundred) per day. All fines must be paid at the account section.
- 17. Students are not allowed to use the phone without the explicit permission of the Administrator/ Hostel in-charge. They must disclose the matter and message before ringing their Parents/ Guardians
- 18. Calling over the phone or meeting the child during the study hour is strictly forbidden.
- 19. Any damage done to the school/hostel property should be made good by the student concerned during his/her stay in the school/ hostel.
- 20. If any Hostellers is found bunking from the hostel, his/her name will be stricken from the school/hostel. Incase the management consider (on the request of parents) to re-admit the child, then the same shall be considered as a fresh admission, followed by school procedure.
- 21. Once the ward is admitted into the hostel, he/she will not be withdrawn under any circumtances. Incase the ward wishes to

- be withdrawn from the hostel permanently, full annual charges are to be paid if withdrawn/ expelled during the session for any reason whatsoever.
- 22. In case of permanent withdraw or explusion from the hostel, no refund whatsoever can be claimed from the hostel/school authorities by the parents/guardians of the child concerned.
- 23. Toiletries and stationary items will be issued to the boarders according to their demand and the same will charged and billed.
